CAMP INFORMATION



Beautifully situated as a peninsula on spring-fed, fish-filled Cedar Lake, Camp Lebanon offers year-round fun for all ages. Famous for delicious food, clean facilities, and friendly staff, Camp is well equipped to provide memory-making experiences for all ages.

PARTICIPANTS: Adults 18 and older from all denominations are welcome at any adult event. Daughters for the Dads N Daughters must be at least 5 years old.

ACTIVITIES: The "funnest fun" begins with Cedar Lake – canoes, kayaks, pedalboats, and pontoons (no extra charge!); fishing (bass, panfish, pike); and hiking trails. Boat ramp and docks available (no charge). More fun features: carpetball, pool tables, foosball, hiking, tree house, canteen, gift shop, Frisbee Golf, 4 Square, crafts, dodgeball, horseshoes, Eagle Ridge, Bass Point, North 40, singing, and more!

HOUSING: Three comfortable options: (1) traditional cabins; (2) dorm-style rooms (Scandinavia / Chalet); and (3) hotel-like units (Cedar Bay Lodge & Birch Point). Not all housing options are available for all events.

CABINS: 15 units each with 5 bunks, 2 single beds. Modern showerhouses nearby.
SCANDINAVIA*: 6 units sleep 3-12, AC, community showers, large meeting room, sun deck.
CHALET*: 6 units sleep 5-11, private sink vanities; AC, community showers, elevator.
CEDAR BAY LODGE/BIRCH POINT*: 18 units sleep 4-5 adults (extra long bunk bed, queen double, rollaway), private full bathrooms.
 (* **Linen service** available: bed sheets, blanket, pillow, towels. Weekends: \$4 per person).

FINANCIAL HELP: While many find Camp's family events to be a great value, camp fees should never be the reason for not attending. Financial Assistance is generously offered based on need and availability of funds. **EZ SCHOLARSHIP** applications are available upon request. Call the Camp Office or mark the box on the registration form.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Refunds are available **up to 3 weeks prior** to an event (less \$25 cancellation fee). **Within three weeks** of the event the entire fee is non-refundable, though it is transferable (less \$25 processing fee) if your spot is filled.
