

Please Note:

We just wanted to let you know that we are following the recommendations of the MN Department of Health in addressing the current H1N1 influenza outbreak. H1N1 novel influenza continues to circulate in Minnesota, and we are taking precautions to decrease the risk of transmission while at camp. Please emphasize with your child the importance of not sharing water bottles, glasses, etc. We will be assisting kids with frequent hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer at all meals. If you think your child has been exposed to the H1N1 influenza virus in the two weeks preceding camp or is experiencing flu-like symptoms, please call camp to discuss. In the unlikely event that we suspect a camper or staff member of showing flu-like symptoms, we will utilize the MN Department of Health's recommended procedures for limiting the spread of the illness.
