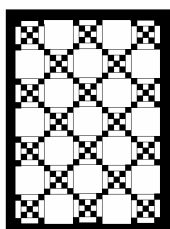
Level 1 Classes teach basics of quilt making including accurate measuring, rotary cutting and machine piecing. This level is great for first-timers and beginners who desire a firmer foundation of quilting tools and methods. Instructors guide with step-by-step instructions from start to finish.

Level 2 Designed for those who have experience in basic cutting, piecing and finishing techniques. Classes focus on a specific pattern or technique.

Level 3 Reserved for those who possess a broad grasp of quilting techniques. Accurate sewing is essential. Classes focus on teaching specific pattern and often involve intricate and precise piecing methods. Participants generally work on their own with instructor assistance available.

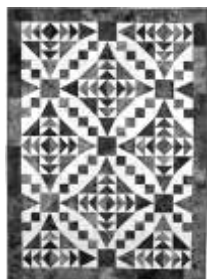
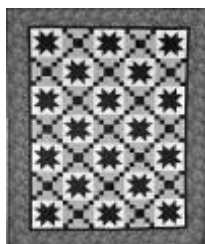


Single Irish Chain Level 1

This class is designed for the first time or beginner quilter. Instructors will guide you step by step in making this timeless favorite! Basic quilting techniques are taught, including rotary cutting, strip piecing, chaining, pressing, and quilt assembly. FREE PATTERN PROVIDED WITH SUPPLY LIST.

Number the Stars Level 2

Sparkling stars float effortlessly amidst Irish Chain blocks to create a dazzling effect in this simple yet simply stunning quilt. This Advanced Beginner or Intermediate pattern features the Lucky Star block concept for perfect stars with ease and success. Pattern Required: *Lucky Stars* by Atkinson Design.



Chain of Events Quilt Level 3

This beautiful quilt showcases curves but is made using only straight seams. Go to www.farflungquilts.com to see different colors and versions of this pattern. A strong contrast of fabrics is needed; make it scrappy or use as few as two fabrics. Pattern Required: *Chain of Events* (\$10, includes shipping and handling).

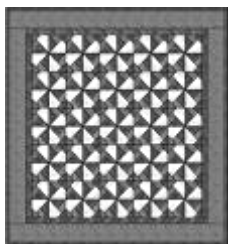
